DWI:

Sergeant Duzan stopped a vehicle for driving in the wrong lane of traffic on Hwy 41. The female driver was intoxicated, failed field sobriety evaluations and was arrested for DWI.



A vehicle was traveling on Engler Blvd with an inoperable headlight, where it was observed and stopped by Officer Schmidt. The male driver was intoxicated and two open containers of vodka were inside the vehicle. He was arrested and charged with DWI and having an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle.

Disturbances:

Two male students were involved in a drug transaction at the Chaska High School. During school hours, one male sold 1/2 gram of marijuana to the other male in a hallway. The incident was captured on school video. The male student who sold the marijuana was charged with both 5th and 4th degree controlled substance crimes. Both charges are felony-level crimes. The male who purchased the marijuana was referred to juvenile court for possession of a small amount of marijuana.



Two juvenile males fought each other in a Chaska Community Center parking lot. The fight occurred after school. The fight was captured on cell phone video and was then placed on Facebook. The police were contacted in reference to the fight. After they investigated the incident, one male was charged with 5th degree assault and the other was charged with disorderly conduct.

Notable:

While driving on Hwy 41, an intoxicated woman lost control and rolled her vehicle in a ditch. Police and paramedics arrived and observed the woman standing next to her vehicle, which was resting upside down. The woman showed obvious signs of intoxication. The officers asked her if she had been drinking and she stated she had not. Numerous cans of beer were lying in the snow around her and the vehicle. The officers pointed to the cans and asked her again. The woman still denied drinking any alcohol. The denial continued even though approximately 40 empty beer cans were visible inside the vehicle. Some of the cans still contained liquid. The woman was transported to a hospital where doctors could examine her. She was charged with 4th degree DWI.
