

FILING FOR CANDIDACY

The following dates are in accordance with Minnesota Statutes:

- Candidate filing opens on Tuesday, August 3, 2010
- Candidate filing closes on Tuesday, August 17, 2010 at 5:00 pm.
- Withdrawal of candidacy deadline is Thursday, August 19, 2010 at 5:00 pm.
- Terms begin Monday, January 3, 2011

The following are the elective non-partisan offices for the City of Chaska that will appear on the November 2, 2010 General Election Ballot:

Mayor (Council Member at Large)

Two-Year Term – January 3, 2011- December 31, 2012

Filing Fee: \$5.00

Salary: \$8,208 annually

First Ward Councilperson

Four-Year Term – January 3, 2011 – December 31, 2014

Filing Fee: \$5.00

Salary: \$6,948 annually

Third Ward Councilperson

Four-Year Term – January 3, 2011 – December 31, 2014

Filing Fee: \$5.00

Salary: \$6,948 annually

Eligibility to Hold Office

Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota:

Every person who by the provisions of this article is entitled to vote at any election and is twenty-one (21) years of age is eligible for any office elective by the people in the district wherein he/she has resided thirty days previous to the election, except as otherwise provided in the Constitution and law of the United States.

To file for Chaska City offices the following items must be filed at the City Clerk's Office at One City Hall Plaza, Chaska, Mn. 55318

Campaign Financial Reports:

* Initial report is due within 14 days after receiving contributions or making disbursements of more than \$750.00.

* Subsequent reports are due 10 days before and 30 days after the election and each year by January 31st until a Final Report is filed.

* A Final Report is due when all debts are settled and all assets are disposed of in excess of \$100.00.

* A Campaign Financial Report Certification of Filing shall be submitted to the City Clerk not later than seven days after the general or special election.
