Residential Burglars Arrested

On Friday, May 27th, Officer Elroy Schmidt was called to investigate a suspected residential burglary of a home on Broadview Avenue. Schmidt found that the front door of the home had been forced open, areas in the home had been "rummaged through", and it was apparent that items of value were missing.

Officer Schmidt was able to make contact with the homeowners – who were out of town – and advised them of the circumstance. Then, with virtually nothing to go on, Schmidt spoke with neighbors up and down the street and began getting pieces and snippets of information about suspicious people and a car that had been seen earlier in the day.

On Saturday, May 28th, Officer Schmidt's work brought him to ultimately arrest Ricardo Alvear Jr., age 24, of Carver, Alberto Alvarez, age 21 of Chaska, and one juvenile male of Chaska for burglary and other crimes.

But for Officer Schmidt's dogged determination, this crime would not have been solved. Officer Schmidt has received a CPD commendation for his work.

Disturbances:

A vehicle was reported stolen from a residence on Clover Ridge Drive. The vehicle was located and stopped in Anoka County. The male offender was arrested. He was charged with vehicle theft and possession of stolen property.



Officers responded to a residence for a domestic abuse complaint involving a man and woman, who are engaged to be married. During the altercation, the man slapped his fiancé across her face. He was arrested and charged with domestic assault.

A burglary was reported at a residence on Stoughton Avenue. Several items were stolen from a detached garage.

Two male students were involved in a verbal confrontation at the Chaska High School. The confrontation escalated and became physical before ending. Both males were referred to juvenile court for disorderly conduct.

One Person's Trash Is Not Chaska's Treasure...

While driving through Community Park on a recent Sunday afternoon, an officer observed a large amount of household garbage in a city dumpster. The dumpster was overflowing with blankets, shoes, pillows, clothing, trash bags and even an old bed frame. The officer sifted through the garbage and located personal information, which led to the male offender. The male admitted to dumping the garbage and stated he would have it removed. He was cited for unlawful deposit of trash.

Several hours later that Sunday, the same officer drove by Community Park and observed additional household trash had been added to the same dumpster. This trash deposit consisted of seven large garbage bags, food waste, food containers and a child's swing set. The officer again went "dumpster diving" and located a US Postal Service mailing box containing a street address. Once again, the officer was able to locate the offender at her residence. The female admitted to the illegal dumping and agreed to remove the trash. She also was cited for unlawful deposit of trash.
