More and more we are receiving and using video evidence in our criminal investigations. In the past, our investigators received video evidence and had only other police officers to help them identify the suspects. For many repeat offenders that method works great. However, not all suspects are well known to officers and we need help from the public. In serious crimes, we have been able seek help from the public with the assistance of television news, but they don't have the air time available for all of our cases. Now, with our web blog we can show you all of our unidentified suspects.

If you recognize one, click the comments button and add the name of the suspect and any other information you might have. The information will be sent directly to an investigator for review. **February Crime Clearance Rate**

Crime clearance rates are calculated and reported by the State of Minnesota every month, quarter, and year. The "clearance rate" shows the percentage of crimes that are solved, or that remain unsolved, and is one important statistic to show the how effective a law enforcement agency is in serving and protecting their community.

The Chaska Police Department cleared **76 %** of all crimes reported in the City of Chaska during the month of February. This is an exceptionally high clearance rate and is testament to the quality service provided by all sworn and non-sworn members of the Chaska Police Department. A high clearance rate, ethical and impartial policing, and quality customer service all help us to fulfill our mission to "Serve. Protect."
