Dayton vs. Bullying

Governor Dayton and Attorney General Swanson have both labeled Minnesota's anti-bullying law as lacking. The Star Tribune has quoted the Governor as saying, "The time has long passed to step up ...". He has called for the creation of a panel of experts, who are charged with reporting back by August 1st, 2012.

The Attorney General proposed legislation to require school districts to respond to reports of bullying in 24 hours, create policies for reporting and documenting incidents, and making of plans for the protection of targets and those who report incidents.

More and more school districts are addressing this issue. This is long overdue and we applaud those who are engaged – for the sake of the bullied and those who bully.

Around the Clock

Chaska Officers issued 37 citations and 26 warnings during this reporting period. There were 208 calls for service

DWI:

Officer Kjorstad stopped a vehicle on Engler Blvd after observing numerous moving violations. The female driver was intoxicated and failed field sobriety evaluations and was arrested. She was charged with 2nd degree DWI and no motor vehicle insurance.

Disturbances:

Two males, who are co-workers at a Chaska business, became involved in a physical altercation in a parking lot on Peavey Road. Officers responded to the lot and located the two males. Both suffered minor injuries and were transported to a hospital for treatment. One male, who initiated the fight, was charged with 5th degree assault.



Police responded to a noise complaint near Isabella Parkway at approximately 4:30 AM one morning. Officers observed a group of males running away as they arrived in the area. Three males were apprehended and charged with fleeing from a peace officer on foot.

A mother and juvenile daughter engaged in an argument over household chores. The argument turned physical and the daughter punched and pushed her mother several times. Police responded to their residence and arrested the daughter. She was charged with domestic assault and 5th degree assault.

While in a bar parking lot, a female requested her fiancé stop drinking and go home. The fiancé became upset and pushed her numerous times before shoving her into the side of a parked vehicle. Police arrived and arrested him for domestic assault.

A vehicle was reported stolen from a residence on North Chestnut Street. Investigation continues.



A male arrived at his home to find his girlfriend's ex-boyfriend sitting on the front porch of his home. The ex-boyfriend was intoxicated, cursed at him, then fell over and struck his head on the pavement. Police took custody of the ex-boyfriend. A breath test indicated a .242 BAC and he was transported to a hospital.

A bottle of sacramental wine and an overhead projector was reported stolen from the Guardian Angels Catholic Church. Investigation continues.

School Incidents:

A male student brought and consumed alcohol from a water bottle during school hours at the Chaska High School. A School Resource Officer gave a breath test to the student and the result was a .165 BAC. The student was charged with minor consumption of alcohol and possession of alcohol on school grounds.

Several drug paraphernalia items were found in a student's vehicle, while it was parked in a lot at the Chaska High School. The student was referred to juvenile court for possession of drug paraphernalia.

Arrested

Recently we reported that we were investigating a theft of money from Heartbreakers Bar. The thefts ranged in time from April through November of this year, and totaled approximately \$8800.00. Detective Kyle Gibbons was assigned this case and on November 7th, arrested Eric Lee Robbins, age 33, of Waconia, who was an employee – until he was arrested.
